## **BOARDING OPTIONS:**

### **1. Full Care Stall (\$650/month)**

*+\$25 additional for premier brick stall*

- 12x12 rubber-matted stall with stall window, hay manger and fan bracket
- Fly spray repellent system
- Twice daily feeding (Hay & Nutrena grain)
- 24/7 fresh water
- Dispense owner-supplied Smartpak supplements
- Daily stall cleaning
- Daily turnout
- Basic blanketing & un-blanketing
- Personal tack locker
- Use of facility during business hours
- 24 hour video surveillance
- Day and night staff watch

### **2. Full Care Pasture (\$425/month)**

- Group grass paddock or pasture with three sided loafing shed
- Year-round forage (grass or round bale)
- Daily feeding (Nutrena grain)
- 24/7 fresh water
- Personal tack locker
- Use of facility during business hours
- Day and night staff watch

### **3. Self Care Stall (\$375/month)**

- 12x12 rubber-matted stall with stall window, hay manger, and fan bracket
- Daily use of group turnout (half-day)
- Dispense pre-prepared morning grain
- Personal tack locker
- Use of facility during business hours
- 24 hour video surveillance
- Staff watch

### ***Training Services Options & Descriptions***

1. **Lesson:** Riding lesson with professional instructor. Typically small group 30-60 minutes in length. Subject to slight length variations depending on horse and rider needs.
2. **Private Lesson:** Private riding lesson with professional instructor. Typically 30 minutes in length. Subject to slight length variations depending on horse and rider needs.
3. **Schooling Rides:** A ride performed by a licensed professional. A schooling ride is a way to school a finished horse correctly on advanced subjects. Typically 30-45 minutes in length. Subject to slight length variations depending on horses needs. Tack, equipment and basic or deluxe grooming provided.
4. **Training Rides:** A ride performed by a licensed professional. A training ride is a way to train an un-finished horse correctly. Typically 30-45 minutes in length. Subject to slight length variations depending on horses needs. Tack, equipment and basic or deluxe grooming provided.
5. **Conditioning:** A exercise ride done by a licensed professional, lunge in a training system or long lining. Conditioning is done with the sole purpose to exercise the horse to increase stamina, fitness, and balance. Rides are executed on various footing to reduce injuries in traveling competition horses. Lunging is performed in a training system. Tack, equipment and basic or deluxe grooming provided.

## **Grooming**

- Show Clipping + Mane Pull: \$35
- Body Clipping: \$150+
- Icing: \$15
- Deworming: \$20
- Bathing: \$50
- Basic tack cleaning: \$15
- Thorough tack cleaning & oiling: \$35

## **Horse Trailering, Transportation**

- Hauling: \$1/mile (\$100 minimum)
- Trailer Parking/Storage: \$25/month
- Hauling to vet: \$75; \$100 if after hours or on holidays

## **Medical Care**

- Vet calls: \$25/per hour (business hours)
- Vet calls (after hours/holidays): \$50/per hour
- Bute: \$5/per 2mg
- Hand Walking: \$25/hour
- Farrier appointment: \$10/hour
- Basic vet wrap: \$15
- Administer Medication: \$5 per time; may vary
- Wound care: Varies
- Adequan: \$55/per dose

## **Facility**

- Facility Damage (stall boards, facility, equipment, jumps, etc.): At cost
- Temporary Board Rate: \$30/night
- Haul-in facility use: \$20/per time or \$100/month unlimited
- Additional Fan: \$35/month per fan
- Lunch: varies

## **Horse Sales & Consulting**

- Leases: Boarders are not permitted to lease a horse to any CEC customer or boarder without express pre-approval of trainer and barn management. All leases are managed by CEC.
- Sales: 10% commission of sale purchase or lease price
- Expense reimbursement: Client is responsible for reimbursing CEC for all expenses incurred, whether or not a sale is consummated.

# **HORSE SHOW SERVICES**

- Trainer Day Fee: \$50
- Trainer & Groom Hotel + Food: \$ (split)
- Grooming and Tack Stall: \$ (split)
- Mileage: \$0.50/per mile
- Day Care: \$25/per day without groom, \$125/day (split) with groom
- Stall set-up expenses: at cost (split)

# **INVOICING**

- Board, shows, training packages, & a la carte services are billed through Cadence Equestrian Center on the 20th of the month & due in advance on the 1st of the month. Board & training is considered late if received after the 5th of the month (late fees will apply).
- Show invoices are due upon receipt.
- Credit card service is available with a 3.5% convenience fee added.
- \$20 service charge for returned payments.

# **MAKEUPS, CREDITS & REFUNDS**

- There are no refunds or credits for cancelled lessons. Students can receive a makeup lesson as long as 24-written notice was given to trainer (by email or text).
- Missed lessons must be made up within 30 days of missed lesson or fees are forfeited.
- Only one makeup lesson is allowed per month, except in medial and uncontrollable situations.
- If multiple lessons will be missed, a comparable service will be substituted for those missed lessons as needed.
- If a horse becomes lame or ill and is unable to complete a package, the services taken to date will be re-calculated at the a la carte price, and the appropriate refund or credit will be given on the next month's invoice.
- There are no training refunds or credits except in cases of horse's lameness or illness.
